SUBJECT: Undergraduate Council Meeting Notice & Agenda for November

The Undergraduate Council will meet on Tuesday, November 21, 2017 during x-period in Torreyson Library, room 206. The following curriculum items will be considered:

Action Items:

1. A proposal from the department of Languages, Linguistics, Literatures, and Cultures to add **LING 3310** Issues in ESL to the list of required courses in the Linguistics major, Track Two (TESOL).
