The Undergraduate Council will meet on Tuesday, October 17, 2017 during x-period in Torreyson Library, room 206. The following curriculum items will be considered:

Action Items:

- A proposal from the department of family and consumer science for new course FACS 4316 / Women in Poverty.
- 2. Proposals from the department of political science:
 - a. To add course **PSCI 4348** / Governments and Politics of the Middle East to the UCA Upper Division Core as an elective in the Diversity area.
 - To add course PSCI 4310 / International Political Economy and Globalization to the UCA
 Upper Division Core as an elective in the Critical Inquiry and Effective Communication
 areas.
 - c. To add course **PSCI 4345** / Governments and Politics of Africa to the UCA Upper Division Core as an elective in the Diversity area.
 - d. To add course **PSCI 3315** / International Law and Organizations to the UCA Upper Division Core as an elective in the Critical Inquiry and Effective Communication areas.
 - e. To add course **PSCI 4312** / China & International Politics to the UCA Upper Division Core as an elective in the Diversity area.

- 4. A proposal from the department of marketing and management to add existing course MGMT 3385 / Safety and Motor Carrier Policy to the UCA Upper Division Core as an elective in the Communication area.

- 5. A proposal from the department of sociology, criminology and anthropology for new course **ANTH 4V80** / Field Archaeology.
