## Criteria for Admission to Level 1 of the Teacher Education Program

Students are responsible for initiating the admission process and ensuring all information is available for the admissions folder. Students should pay close attention to application deadlines as published by the Office of Professional Field Services. After midterm grading and prior to established interview dates, students may initiate the process of admission upon completion of the minimum requirements listed below.

2.5 GPA (including UCA, transfer, and cumulative).

Grade of "C" or better in WRTG 1310 and 1320, SPCH 1300, MATH 1360 or 1390, EDUC 1300 And 1320.

Grade of "C" or better in all major requirements (art, art education, and education courses).

Successful completion of Praxis I exam.

Completion of 45 semester hours (or current enrollment in sufficient hours to complete 45 semester hours).

Two completed Admission Evaluations from faculty (one being from student's EDUC 1300 instructor).

Successful completion of student interview by art faculty with recommendation for admission. Sign up in the Office of Professional Field Services.

Successful completion of the Department of Art Sophomore Major Advancement Interview (SMAI).

Criteria for Admission to Level II of the Teacher Education Program (Directed Teaching) Successful completion of the three content area Praxis II exams: Art Making; Art – Content, Traditions, Criticism, and Aesthetics; and Art – Content Knowledge.

During the Internship II semester, teacher candidates take Praxis II: Principles of Learning and Teaching.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The program is 125 semester credit hours if student passes competency test for EDUC 1220. The degree includes 44 general education hours, 12-14 hours of professional education, 21 hours of art education (including directed teaching) and 45 hours of art (including 12 hours of art history). Art courses must follow a prerequisite structure.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Due to student teaching internship and field experiences for education courses, it is recommended students complete 6-10 hours of required General Education courses in the summer of their sophomore or junior year.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Prerequisites for ART 2140, Portfolio I, are ART 1310, 1321, 2312, 2322, and 3 hours from 2325, 2335, or 2336. Students may enroll in ART 2140 if they have completed four of the five prerequisites and are enrolled in the fifth.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Art Ed Emphasis students must have at least one 2-D and one 3-D Studio I level course.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> Only the 2000 level Foreign Language is required; however, students with no previous experience with a foreign language may need to enroll in up to six hours of lower-level instruction in order to complete the 2000 level course.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> Directed Teaching semester should be completed in the Spring semester when possible.
