

M.S. Graduate Assistantship position at the University of Central Arkansas: Cell Biology

Description: A Master's level graduate assistantship position in cell biology is available (dependent upon availability of teaching assistantship position) in the Biology Department at the University of Central Arkansas starting Spring/Fall 2013. The student will be involved in investigating the molecular mechanism of mitochondrial dynamics in the model systems of *Dictyostelium discoideum* or *Saccharomyces cerevisiae*. The student will be trained in molecular biology, cell biology, microscopy techniques *etc.*

Qualifications: B.S. in Biology, Cell Biology or related fields. Minimum GPA of 3.0 and a combined quantitative/ verbal GRE score of 300 on the new scale. Successful candidates should be highly motivated and must have the ability to work both independently and in a team. Prior experience in cell and/or molecular biology is preferred.
