Subject: Scholarships - Miscellaneous

Members of Student Government Association

(Adopted 12/75; Revised 6/96, 8/00, 8/01, 12/05, 11/08, 10/13)

The Board of Trustees authorizes a scholarship equal to one-half of tuition and mandatory fees. If residing in university housing, the scholarship also includes actual charges not to exceed an amount equal to full room and board charges based on single-occupancy rate and Total Access meal plan (maximum of \$900 dining dollars for full summer) each fall, spring, May intersession, summer I and summer II semesters. This scholarship is authorized for the Student Government Association positions of executive vice president, vice president of finance, and vice president of operations; and the Student Activities Board president during their terms of office.

The Board of Trustees also authorizes a scholarship equal to full tuition and mandatory fees. If residing in university housing, the scholarship also includes actual charges not to exceed an amount equal to full room and board charges based on single-occupancy rate and Total Access meal plan (maximum of \$900 dining dollars for full summer) each fall, spring, May intersession, summer I and summer II semesters. This scholarship is authorized for the Student Government Association president during his/her term of office.

These scholarships, as explained above, are available to the summer executives serving by appointment in the place of the elected executive officers.

The Board of Trustees also authorizes the Student Government Association positions of executive president, executive vice president, vice president of operations, and vice president of finance to be paid \$11.00 per hour up to ten hours per week with a maximum of sixteen weeks each fall and spring semester.

Governors of Boys and Girls State

(Adopted 02/65)

A four-year fee remission scholarship is established for the governors of Boys State and Girls State.

Mentor Teachers

(Adopted 03/86; Revised 08/00, 02/13)

The University of Central Arkansas will provide three hours of fee waiver (registration and mandatory fees) to a teacher who serves as a mentor teacher in any semester. These hours must be used within one calendar year following the end of the semester in which they are earned, unless the dean of the College of Education allows an exception. The hours are not transferable.
