constituting a quorum of said Board, at which meeting the following business was transacted, to-wit:

Minutes of the last meeting were approved upon motion made by Mrs. Hammans, seconded by Mr. Jones, and passed by unanimous vote.

Motion was made by Dr. Johnson and seconded by Mr. Burton that the Board recognizes House Concurrent Resolution #18 of 1981. Motion further stipulated that Trustees are of the opinion the university is in compliance with said Resolution. The motion was passed by unanimous vote.

Adoption of the following resolution was approved upon motion made by Dr. Johnson, seconded by Mrs. Hammans, and passed by unanimous vote:

"RESOLVED: The university will enter into a contract with the Conway Corporation to provide cable television to the rooms in the residence halls. The Conway Corporation will provide all the wiring and installation equipment at a cost of \$3.50 per room per month for the nine months of the regular school term. The expenses for this will be recovered by a charge of \$2.50 for each residence hall occupant each pay period. The contract shall not obligate the university for a period longer than one year."

Adoption of the following resolution was approved upon motion made by Dr. Sneed, seconded by Mr. Johnson, and passed by unanimous vote:

"RESOLVED: The contract with Scramble Snack Systems of Arkansas be renewed for the period beginning June 1, 1980 through May 31, 1982. Scramble Snack Systems of Arkansas will pay to the university \$1,400 per month during the period of this contract."

Adoption of the following resolution was approved upon motion made by Mrs. Hammans, seconded by Mr. Jones, and passed by unanimous vote:

"RESOLVED: The health insurance contract with Blue Cross, Blue Shield be extended for a year with the addition of a \$200 deductible on Blue Cross to replace the present \$50 deductible."

Adoption of the following resolution was approved upon motion made by Mr. Jones, seconded by Dr. Johnson and passed by the following vote:

AYES: Mr. Jones, Dr. Johnson, Dr. Sneed, Mrs. Hammans, and Mr. Burton

"RESOLVED: The student activity fee, effective August 15, 1981, will become \$15 per seme ster charged to regular students. Students enrolled for seven or fewer hours will pay half of this \$15 fee."

Adoption of the following resolution was approved upon motion made by Dr. Johnson seconded by Mr. Johnson, and passed by unanimous vote:

"RESOLVED: The Board of Trustees authorizes the administration to negotiate with the City of Conway the construction of Farris Road between College Avenue and Highway #286. The university is to provide the right-ofway and construction materials at a cost not to exceed \$70,000."

Copies of the financial report as of March 31, 1981 were distributed and interpreted by Mr. Bob McCormack, Controller.

Executive session for the purpose of considering personnel was declared upon motion made by Dr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Johnson, and unanimously approved.
