Dr. Chakales was welcomed to the Board.

Dr. Farris reported on the following:

- 1. shared copies of correspondence pertaining to our selective admission policy,
- 2. distributed copies of the fall student withdrawal report,
- 3. 1985-86 operating budget status,
- 4. progress on microfilming student records,
- 5. recent accreditation visits (Occupational Therapy, National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education, and North Central Association), and
- 6. Department of Psychology Self-Study.

Mr. Patterson, Vice President for Public Affairs, distributed copies of an "Advancement Report" covering 1982-83-84. This effort was aimed at increasing the public awareness of and support for UCA. He also shared information comparing student recruitment figures for freshman applications for the past three years.

Dr. Dunn, Director of Governmental Relations, distributed copies of a recent study he completed analyzing the recent session of the General Assembly. Dr. Dunn also discussed the distribution of general revenues (percentages) to institutions of higher education.

The following resolutions awarding food service and snack bar contracts for 1985-86 were adopted upon motion made by Mr. Ahlf, seconded by Mrs. Hammans, and passed by unanimous vote:

> "BE IT RESOLVED: The administration be authorized to sign a one-year extension of the 1984-85 food service contract with the ARA Food Service Company for 1985-86 at student rates as follows: Summer - \$3.947 per day for 21-meal plan and \$4.60 per day for 15-meal plan. Regular Academic Year - \$3.125 per day for 21-meal plan, \$2.915 per day for any 15-meal plan, and \$3.689 per day for 15-meal plan. Off Campus Special Groups will be charged as follows: Breakfast \$2.15 per day; Lunch \$2.75 per day; Dinner \$2.75 per day. Casual Meal charges will be: Breakfast \$2.50 per day; Continental \$1.05 per day; Lunch \$3.25 per day; Dinner \$3.25 per day; and, Steak or Special \$4.10 per day."

> "BE IT RESOLVED: The snack bar operation in the Student Center be contracted to ARA Food Service for the period beginning June 1, 1985 through May 31, 1986. ARA will pay the University \$13,000 per year or 13% of sales, whichever is greater during the period of this contract."

The following three resolutions for additions to the Capital Project Priority List were adopted upon motion made by Mrs. Hammans, seconded by Dr. Johnson, and passed by unanimous vote:

"BE IT RESOLVED: The Board of Trustees approves the expenditure of \$31,000 to cover the preparation and publication costs of 2,000 copies of a pictorial history of the first 75 years of the University of Central Arkansas."

"BE IT RESOLVED: The Board of Trustees approves an expenditure of \$155,000 for brick veneer and roof overhang construction for the Administration Building."

"BE IT RESOLVED: The Board approves the use of \$65,000 currently allocated to the Computer Center and an additional \$45,000 for the purchase of additional disk drives and tape drives for the central computer."

The following resolution setting general registration fees for 1985-86 was adopted upon motion made by Mrs. Hammans and seconded by Dr. Chakales with the following vote: AYES: Burton, Johnson, Jones, Hammans, Ahlf, and Chakales. NO: White:

> "BE IT RESOLVED: Effective with the Fall Semester, 1985, the general registration fee at the University of Central Arkansas will be \$38.50 per hour through 11 hours with a maximum of \$435 for students enrolled in 12 or more hours. Non-Arkansas residents will pay twice this fee."

The following resolution waiving out-of-state fees for Graduate Assistants was adopted upon motion made by Mrs. Hammans, seconded by Dr. Johnson, and passed by unanimous vote:

> "BE IT RESOLVED: Students who are non-Arkansas residents and who are awarded a Graduate Assistantship will have their out-of-state tuition waived in addition to receiving the regular stipend paid to Graduate Assistants."

 $\sqrt{}$ Effective the Fall Semester, 1985, the following tuition for coursework offered for credit through Continuing Education and Instructor pay through Continuing Education were approved upon motion made by Dr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. White, and passed by unanimous vote: Little Rock Air Force Base courses - \$58 per semester hours; all other credit courses - \$40 per semester hour; Instructor pay - \$1,275 per three-hour course.

The following resolution adopting student housing and food service rates for 1985-86 was passed by unanimous vote upon motion made by Dr. Johnson, and seconded by Mrs. Hammans:

> "BE IT RESOLVED: The following charges for student housing and food service will be effective at the beginning of the Fall Semester, 1985:

University of Central Arkansas' Purple Circle Policies

- I. UCA's athletic policy on non-school organizations supporting the Athletic Department will be:
 - A. The NAIA requires that the University of Central Arkansas have complete control over all funds being given to assist the school's athletic program and be coordinated with the Athletic Department's budget. Expenditures from this fund will be used by the Athletic Office for athletic purposes.
 - B. The institution must remain in control of its destiny, and local organizations have no authority to act on their own, other than in those instances specifically authorized by the University.
- II. The objectives of the Purple Circle Club are:
 - A. To assist in the planning and implementation of annual fund drive of the Purple Circle group.
 - B. To create better understanding and support of UCA's athletic program.
 - C. To encourage athletes and non-athletes to attend UCA.
 - D. To obtain some goals for the UCA Athletic Department that it could not otherwise accomplish without outside aid.

Each Purple Circle Chapter will have its own slate of officers which will consist of President, Vice President, and Secretary chosen by the members of that chapter.
