President Snow outlined to the Board the new approach that will be made to the Legislature for the 1965-67 biennium.

Trustee Mitchell made a motion that was seconded by Trustee Hoggard and unanimously passed that President Snow, Trustee Harper, and Trustee West investigate any means by which the College might obtain funds to construct and improve athletic facilities on the campus.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourme d.
