Summer salary rates to be in accordance with 1969-71 State College of Arkansas Appropriation Act.

A second to this motion was made by Trustee Morgan and passed by unanimous vote. A copy of this Agreement is attached to these minutes and becomes a part thereof.

A motion was made by Trustee Mitchell that the Contract for Architectural Services between Bruce R. Anderson, Architect, and State College of Arkansas (renovation of Meadors Hall--as amended) be approved. A second to this motion was made by Trustee Ahlf and passed by unanimous vote. A copy of this Agreement is attached to these minutes and becomes a part thereof.

Trustee Harper made a motion that effective June 1, 1969 the following cafeteria charges be placed into effect:

Meal tickets per five weeks summer term--\$62.50

Meal tickets per pay period (8 times) during the nine months regular school year--\$50.00

Anyone paying cash for meals--breakfast \$1.00; lunch and dinner \$1.25; Sunday dinner (noon) \$1.50.
