The Board of Trustees, Arkansas State Teachers College, met in the President's office at 1:00 P.M. Sunday, May 19, pursuant to written notice of the meeting and its purposes as authorized by the Chairman Trustee Bachelor, Johnston, Cox, Guthridge, Parham and Colvert were present. Trustee Elton was absent.

Chairman Bachelor announced that a quorum was present and directed that the minutes of the last meeting be read. The minutes were read and approved.

Chairman Bachelor then declared the Board of Trustees ready for items of old and new business.

President Irby reported the stages of progress toward securing a highway sign for the college; the renovation of the training school building; the construction of tennis courts, all projects formerly authorized by the Board of Trustees. He also reported the receipt of additional excess and surplus property from the W.A.A. and Stuttgart Air Field, and of plans through a cooperative project with the city government for paving the block immediately east of the college campus.

President Irby read to the Board a letter from Governor Ben Laney which asked that college funds be divided between the First National Bank of Conway and the First State Bank of Conway, and reported discussions he had previously with officials of each bank. Trustee Johnston made a motion that college cash funds be distributed as nearly equally as possible between the two banks, and that the distribution be made in such way as to cause the college least inconvenience. Trustee Parham seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Trustee Colvert, seconded by Trustee Cox, rental for the college store is reestablished at 10 percent of gross instead of 7½ percent as now charged, and that the 10 percent rentals be made effective on and after July 1, 1946. The motion carried unanimously.

The matter of charging extra fees for students enrolled from out of the State was discussed at length but by general consent final action was deferred for a subsequent meeting of the Board.

Chairman Bachelor directed the President to notify Mr. M. E. Newbern, Manager of the College Store, and candidate for democratic committeeman, that employees of the college, by action of the Board of Trustees, May 25, 1942, will not actively participate in political campaigns, and that because of his close connection with the college, he should feel himself bound by board action.

President Irby presented recommendations for the selection of personnel for the academic year 1946-47, and requested authority to fill vacancies still existant when possible to secure acceptably trained personnel.

Trustee Guthridge made the motion that the President be authorized to fill vacancies and that his recommendation as to personnel, listed following, and their salaries be approved. Trustee Parham seconded the motion which carried unanimously.
