March 15, 1948

The Board of Trustees, Arkansas State Teachers College, met in the President's office at 10 A.M. March 15, 1948, pursuant to legal call by the Chairman. Chairman R A. Cox; Vice-Chairman Amis Guthridge; O. H. Parham; Jas. S. Colvert; Dr. J. R. Flanagin and Silas D. Snow, Members, were present. Secretary, Mrs. Pauline Johnston, was absent. Architect Bruce Anderson, College Bursar Harold Eidson and President Nolen M. Irby also met with the Board.

After roll call, Chairman Cox declared a quorum present and directed that the minutes of the previous meeting be read. Trustee Guthridge moved that the minutes be approved as read. Trustee Parham seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

The Chairman asked for any items of business which might legally be acted upon by the Board of Trustees at this meeting.

Trustee Guthridge made the motion that the Board of Trustees consider all sealed bids submitted for the erection of the Training School Building. Trustee Parham seconded the motion. Chairman Cox directed Architect Bruce Anderson to open and read in the presence of the Board of Trustees and contractors or their representatives all bids.

Bids opened and read orally were as follows:

Chairman Cox asked that all constructors withdraw from the meeting and asked the Bozrd of Trustees to consider the bids and to propose action. After lengthy discussion Trustee Guthridge made the motion that the bids submitted by Seth E. Giem and Associates, the lowest bid, be accepted and that contracts be signed by the officers of the Board, authorizing the erection of the building to begin at once. Trustee Parham seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Chairman Cox noted the absence of Secretary Johnston, and upon motion by Trustee Guthridge, seconded by Trustee Snow, Trustee Jas. S. Colvert was elected as Acting Secretary by acclamation. Chairman Cox and Acting Secretary Colvert signed the contract for the erection of the Training School Building for and in behalf of the college, add Earl Pyle, Partner, signed for and in behalf of Seth E. Giem and Associates. The contract duly noted that the college might exercise option One in Bid Form within a period of 30 days if investigation by college authorities proved the option to the advantage of the college.

The Committee on College Insurance reported that the insurance on the Veterans Dormitory had been scheduled and that a total of \$1,747,300.00 is scheduled insurance is now in effect.

Trustee Snow made the motion that the following repairs be approved. Trustee Parham seconded the motion which carried unanimously.
