The Board of Trustees, Arkansas State Teachers College, met in the President's office, Arkansas State Teachers College, Conway, Arkansas, Thursday, March 31, 1955 pursuant to legal call of the meeting by the Chairman. The following members were present: Chairman James H. Flanagin; Vice-Chairman O. H. Parham; Louie H. Polk; Sam E. Adkisson and John W. Sneed, Jr. Trustees Morgan and Ashmore were absent.

President Snow met with the Board.

Chairman Flanagin directed roll call and announced a quorum present and called the meeting into formal session.

Minutes of the last meeting of the Board were approved as read.

Chairman Flanagin presented Dr. John W. Sneed of Conway, and welcomed him as a member of the Board of Trustees on behalf of the Board, faculty, and students of Arkansas State Teachers College. Dr. Sneed expressed his pleasure at the opportunity to serve as a member of the Board.

Chairman Flanagin stated that the election of officers for the Board of Trustees for the next year was in order. The Board unanimously reelected Dr. James H. Flanagin as Chairman; Mr. O. H. Parham, Vice-Chairman and Mrs. Rufus W. Morgan,

Jr., Secretary.

Chairman Flanagin called for items of old or pending business.

Mr. Bruce Anderson, Architect, presented a Campus Plot Plan and upon the motion of Trustee Parham, seconded by Trustee Adkisson, the Board unanimously accepted the plan as presented.

President Snow and Business Manager Eidson reported on the 1955 General Assembly as it would affect Arkansas State Teachers College.

There being no other items of pending business, Chairman Flanagin called for items of new business.

The Budget for 1955-56, submitted and recommended by the administration was unanimously approved and formally adopted. The budget is listed below:

Trustee Sneed made the motion, seconded by Trustee Polk, that beginning first summer term, 1955, tuition be charged students in the Training School at the rate of \$2.50 per month per child for nine months and \$3.00 per student for five weeks summer term. The motion passed unanimously.

Trustee Adkisson made the motion seconded by Trustee Polk and unanimously approved by the Board that personnel list as submitted be elected for the year 1955-56.

Trustee Adkisson made the motion, seconded by Trustee Parham that the following statement of policy governing faculty leave of absence with pay be approved:

## STATEMENT OF POLICY GOVERNING FACULTY LEAVE OF ABSENCE WITH PAY

A regular member of the instructional staff may be granted a leave of absence with full pay during the second five-week summer term within the following limitations:

- A new staff member cannot qualify until his fourth summer of service.
- Staff members with more than four years of service may qualify every third summer.
- 3. Leaves of absence are not cumulative.
- 4. Institutional needs receive prior consideration in determining the number of staff members who may qualify. If such needs impose a limit upon the number who may qualify, priorities are assigned in the following order:
  - a. Faculty members who request leave to earn credits toward higher degrees for which they are candidates.
  - b. Faculty members who do not hold the doctorate and are not candidates for that degree, but who request leave to earn additional graduate credits.
  - c. Faculty members who hold the doctorate and who request leave for individual research on a project approved by the president and the dean.
  - d. Faculty members who request leave to pursue projects, approved by the president and the dean, which do not yield graduate credit.
- 5. A leave of absence with pay may be granted more readily where departmental offerings do not necessitate the employment of a replacement.
- 6. Leaves of absence should be planned with the long-range departmental offerings in view, with leaves staggered in a manner to permit a majority of department members to be available if needed.

The motion passed unanimously.

President Snow reviewed the work of the Graduate Committee, whose creation had been authorized by the Board of Trustees a year ago, and recommended that Arkansas State Teachers College jointly with Arkansas State College and Henderson State Teachers College announce the inauguration of a Fifth-Year Program of Teacher Education leading to the Degree of Master of Science in Education. The entire committee consisting of Dean A. E. Burdick, Chairman; Dr. Ben A. Lewis; Dr. H. L. Minton; Dick M. Allen and Harold D. Eidson, appeared before the Board and each spoke for its adoption. A motion by Trustee Polk, seconded by Trustee Sneed was made to establish a graduate program. The motion passed unanimously.

President Snow announced the Second Annual Service Award Banquet for all employees of Arkansas State Teachers College would be held Tuesday evening, April 5 and invited all members of the Board to attend.

The Trial Balance ending February 28, 1955 was presented by Business Manager Eidson.

There being no further items of business, the Board adjourned until legally called into session again.
