The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Hon. J. L. Bond and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:-


Miss Mary H. Nash, a graduate of Peabody College for teachers at Nashville, Tenn., was elected critic teacher at a salary of \$137.50 per month.
