The maeting was called to order by Honorable a. B. Hill, chairman, and the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

On the recommendation of Mr. Torreyson and upon motion of Hon. W. E. Lenon, miss Dollie Randelman was elected teacher of Home Economics to take the place of Mrs. G. Y. Short, whose resignation had been accepted at a salary of \$1,700.00 per annum effective october 1st. 1924, Hon. W.E. Lenon, Hon. Joe Frauenthal, Hon. A. B. Hill and Joe Ferguson voting for the motion.

On motion of W. E. Lenon, seconded by Joe rerguson, Miss Connie Lee Taylor was elected stemographer and her salary raised to \$75.00 per month beginning October the first, 1924, Hon. W. E. Lenon, Hon. Joe Frauenthal, Hon. A. B. Hill and Joe Ferguson voting for the motion.

On motion of Hon. W. E. Lenon, Mr. Torreyson was authorized to employ such emergency teachers as might be necessary for the efficient and proper conduct of the State Normal School. Hon. W. E. Lenon, Hon. Joe Frauenthal, Hon. A. B. Hill and Joe Ferguson voting for the motion.

The board adjourned subject to the call of the cuairman.
