Mrs. Gibson, was elected Assistant Librarian at a salary of \$90.00 per month, succeeding Miss shaw, resigned.

The account for improvements and buildings at the State Normal School in the amount of \$8.250.99 was examined and approved.

The salary of Guy Smith, Registrar, was raised from \$201.00 per month to \$220.00 per month, in recognizition of his work in systematizing the records of the School and of the Students. Raise to be effective October 1st. 1924.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the Board adjourned, subject to the call of the Chairman.
