On this the 7th day of February 1933, the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas State Teachers College met in the office of the State Commissioner of Education at the State Capital in Little Rock, Arkansas with the following members present and voting Hirst, Leonard, Compere, Humphreys.

An explanation of the finances of the Institution for the remainder of the present fiscal year on account of the failure of the Bank of Conway, where all institutional cash funds were deposited, was made by President McAlister. Motion by Compere, seconded by Humphries that:

That since this will overdraw the state appropriation for salaries for the present fiscal year, that salaries of all members of the faculty be reduced 8 per cent for the remaining five months of the present fiscal year.

Motion carried.

There was a general discussion of a proposed bill to pay for the library building and the one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) due the premanent school fund, the indebtedness to be paid from the income derived from the cigarette tax alloted to the Arkanses State. Teachers College by Act 19 of the Acts of 1921. Mr. Daws was requested to introduce the bill and work for its passage.

A proposed bill for appropriations for salaries, wages and maintenance for the next biennium was presented and discussed. After approval Fresilant McAlister and Representative Dawson were requested to present the bill to Mr. Smith, the State Comptroller, and the Budget Committee for their approval.

The Board adjourned subject to the call of the Fresident.
