

The Board of Trustees of the Arkansas State Normal met August 12th, 1918 with the following members present: Bond, Oliver, Lenon, Dunaway and McDaniel.

Certain supplies for the use of the school were ordered purchased with Mr. Torreyson, to do the buying.

The sum of \$100 was authorized expended by the Normal out of the Library and Incidental fund for the school attendance encouragement movement now going on in the state.

Several vacancies in the teaching force at the school were authorized to be filled by Mr. Torreyson and to report at next meeting his selections.

Bids for the installation of vacuum pump in Central Heating Plant, and for the correction of heating conditions in the teaching building and for wrapping of heat mains in tunnels were then opened in the presence of the board. Said bids were in words and figures as follows: Pettit and Galloway,
