And the following teachers and other employees were given a raise of Six and one quarter Dollars per month, to-wit: C.C.Denny, Guy E.Smith, Mrs.H.F.Hess, N.F.Cooledge, Constance Mitchell and J.G.Cubage.

At the suggestion of Honorable J.L.Bond, the expense account of Judge A.E.Hutchins for a round trip from Augusta to Little Rock, amounting to \$8.57 was allowed and ordered paid.

The Board adjourned subject to the call of the chairman.
