



February 20th, 1917.

The Executive Committee met in the office of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction February 20th, 1917, with all of the members present except Mr. McDaniel.

The President of the school asked for an appropriation of \$20.00 a month from the Incidental and Library Fund for the payment of an instructor of the Normal School Band on three evenings a week. After some discussion the matter was deferred and referred to the full Board of Trustees at its next meeting. The President was given permission to expend \$50.00 from the Incidental and Library Fund for athletic supplies. He was also authorized to purchase a typewriter desk provided he is unable to borrow one not now in use from the Custodian of the Capitol.
