

Dear Prospective Applicant,

We are pleased that you are interested in the University of Central Arkansas Speech-Language Pathology Master's Degree Program. As indicated on the department web page, all applications will now be handled through the CSDCAS website. Their site will provide you with all the information that you will need to complete the on line application. This has many advantages for you. You will be able to monitor their receipt of your letters of recommendation, transcripts, and GRE scores. This will result in a much more organized application process for you.

**You only need to apply to the UCA Graduate School when you are accepted to the program by the UCA Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders. You should, however, have your GRE scores from ETS sent to the UCA Graduate School to facilitate this process.**

We do not begin to review applications until the application deadline. Decisions about admission are made after all applications are reviewed. Each application is reviewed in its entirety, independently, by at least two members of the faculty in the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders. Recommendations are then made by the Graduate Committee to the entire faculty for discussion and finally decisions as to admissions are made.

We hope to complete the application review process by the middle of March. You can expect to hear by e mail about the status of your application soon after that.
