Students who do not hold a bachelor's degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders must complete:

1. 27 hours in *Communication Sciences & Disorders

- CSD 2306 Neuroscience for Communication
- CSD 2322 Applied Phonetics
- CSD 3321 Language Acquisition and Literacy
- CSD 3306 Anatomy and Physiology for Communication Sciences and Disorders
- CSD 3311 Fundamentals of Speech and Hearing Science
- CSD 3335 Birth to Five: Assessment and Intervention
- CSD 3301 Articulation and Phonological Disorders
- CSD 4311 Audiology

2. Courses required to meet ASHA requirements for basic sciences and statistics

- 1 Biology course, with lab (must be human or animal, e.g., Botany would not meet this requirement)
- 1 Chemistry or Physical Science course, with lab
- 1 Statistics course (must be a stand-alone class)
- 1 Behavioral Science course (psychology, sociology, anthropology, etc)
- *Course names from other universities may vary but have the same content. If you have a question regarding credit for a given course, contact the CSD graduate advisor. Please keep all syllabi from courses taken at other universities as they might be needed determine course equivalency.
 - Pre-requisite courses do not have to be taken at UCA. Several universities in Arkansas and across the
 United States offer these courses; some offer them in a distance-learning format. We do not keep a
 current list of those universities, as they change often. Our best advice is to do an internet search for
 "speech-pathology leveling courses."
 - To register for undergraduate post-baccalaureate leveling courses at UCA, go to www.uca.admissions/apply
 - You will be applying as a post-baccalaureate student.
 - Completing post-baccalaureate coursework in CSD does NOT guarantee admission into the UCA CSD Graduate Program. Application to the CSD Master's Program would made in the last semester or pre-requisite work.
 - At this time UCA does not offer any of its undergraduate courses in a distance-learning format.
 - All pre-requisite courses must be completed before beginning master's level coursework, but application can be made in the last semester of pre-requisite work.
