COE CURRICULUM AND ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE 2014-2015

CHARGE:

- 1. To review the need for undergraduate and graduate courses or programs as proposed by the departments.
- 2. To approve and recommend the content of each proposed course or program.
- 3. To approve and recommend the assessment plan for each proposed course or program.

MEMBERSHIP:

Six faculty members – the Chair of each departmental curriculum committee and one member from each department, appointed by the College Administrative Council for three-year terms, with the original members being assigned one-year, two-year, or three-year terms by lot, in order to insure the committee's continuity.

Two students - one graduate student and one undergraduate student to be appointed each year by the Committee Membership.

Vacancies will be filled by the College Administrative Council.

OFFICERS:

Chair:

The Chair of the Committee is elected annually and must have served on the committee for a year or more to be eligible to serve as Chair.

The chair of the College Curriculum Committee or PEC serves on the University Academic Planning and Assessment Committee.
