

**COE RESEARCH COMMITTEE
2014-2015**

CHARGE:

1. To encourage and support faculty research. More specifically, the College of Education Research Committee is to hold a meeting early during each Fall semester with all untenured tenure-track faculty to review College promotion and tenure guidelines and to plan support mechanisms to promote faculty research.
2. To review and recommend research to be supported by institutional research funds.
3. To arrange opportunities for faculty to share their research and scholarly accomplishments.
4. To review applicant proposals for Summer Research Incentive Support and make recommendations for funding to the Dean by April 1 of each Spring semester.

MEMBERSHIP:

Six faculty members (2 per department) who shall be appointed by the College Academic Council for three-year terms. The original members shall be assigned one-year, two-year, or three-year terms by lot, in order to insure the committee's continuity. Vacancies will be filled by the College Academic Council.

The Dean or Associate Dean shall serve as an ex-officio member.

OFFICERS:

Chair: The chair will be elected annually by all members of the committee. To be eligible to be elected as chair, the faculty member must have served one year or more on the committee.

The chair will serve on the University Research Council.

MEETINGS:

To be called by the Chair.

REPORTS TO:

Dean, College of Education
