These courses are not included in this plan of study. Please note that such need may void the guaranteed Eight-Semester Plan.

Minor requirements range from 18 to 27 credit hours; the student will need to adjust the number of general elective and minor elective credit hours in this PCP as needed depending upon the chosen minor field of study.
