- The minutes from the January meeting were amended and approved.
- Graham Gillis Health Benefit Update
  - UCA absorbed an approximately 9% increase in January 2012
  - o HR is working with Stephens (consultant) to explore UCA's options and work to get benefits on a fiscal-year-basis rather than a calendar-year-basis; this will help with budgeting and planning from year to year.
  - o The three options of insurance providers UCA has are Blue Cross Blue Shield, United HealthCare and QualChoice.
  - The increase in cost is not yet set in stone. All of us have the potential to have more out-of-pocket costs, but in reality, this would affect a relatively small percentage of the entire group.
  - o We could eventually become self-insured, but we do not have the resources available to do that at this time. We might consider budgeting a portion of our reserves to have on hand for this in the future.
  - o Another option to explore would be to form a consortium with other state colleges and universities to increase our buying power.

  - o SBAC
    - § The SBAC will have the mission of funding SPARC initiatives
    - § There will be a more proportionate balance of staff (both classified and non-classified) and faculty representation on the new SBAC as opposed to the old BAC
    - § Clarity in the reporting order this committee reports directly to the President (not to Executive Staff)

- § SBAC needs to begin planning budgets in ways that affect more than just a year-to-year basis.
- Financial status updates will be given at the next meeting.
- Be mindful that elections are coming up some committee members will change with new senators coming in as some others exit
