Financial Aid Eligibility

In order to apply for federal financial aid, all students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and request that the results be sent to the Home Institution. The Home Institution will request other documents, as necessary and will communicate directly with the student regarding eligibility. Once the FAFSA is completed, it is always a good idea to follow up with the Financial Aid Office at the Home Institution.
