REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS

To ensure time for processing, applications must be complete (including official transcripts) at least one month prior to the beginning of the term for which the student wishes to enroll. Note: Some programs have set earlier application deadlines. Please check with the department's website for their additional application requirements.

Applicants for admission to the Graduate degree programs must submit the following:

1. One (1) completed copy of this application form.
2. One (1) copy of **Official transcripts** from all colleges and universities (except UCA) you have attended, including one which indicates that you have earned a baccalaureate degree from an accredited four-year institution. Transcripts must have the official seal and be mailed directly from the institutions previously attended to the UCA GRADUATE SCHOOL (not Admissions).
3. Score report on the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) Must be less than 5 years old. Exception: MBA or MAcc students only must take the Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT)
4. **A \$25.00 non-refundable application fee.**

The applicant must have completed the required undergraduate background in the field of proposed academic emphasis. To be admitted with **full qualifications**, you must have earned an overall minimum undergraduate grade point average of 2.7 (A=4) or at least a 3.0 in your last 60 semester hours and submitted GRE/GMAT scores. Students who do not meet the requirements for admission with full qualifications may be granted admission under conditions outlined in the *Graduate Bulletin*.
