## RESPONSIBILITIES

Coordinate schedule with other GA.

Answer the phone and direct calls or take messages, observing proper etiquette.

Greet visitors enthusiastically and direct them to appropriate offices.

Be familiar with the campus map (particularly where the Provost, President, and Grants Accounting Offices are located).

Deliver documents around campus, considering all delivery requests urgent.

Accurately file Sponsored Programs and Research Compliance files daily.

Enter student opportunities into the STOPS database using FileMaker Pro. Train faculty to use the GRC's GrantSearch, and SPIN/SMARTS databases. Train students to use STOPS.

Process Research Compliance (RC) applications and continuing reviews. Answer faculty and student researcher questions regarding RC.

Update the SPO & RCO websites and databases (Filemaker Pro) as directed.

Clean out and rearrange file cabinets as necessary. Carry out light housekeeping duties (organizing cupboards, dusting, etc.). Get water for coffee maker and icemaker.
