COPA hours of operation (Fall and Spring semester):

Monday - Friday, 12pm – 6pm Sunday, 3pm – 6pm

Pay scale and hours:

Begins at \$8.50 (minimum wage), with opportunity for raises based on skills set related to COPA duties. A student worker CANNOT work more than 40 hours each week.

Duties include:

This is a MANUAL LABOR oriented job. Basic duties are equipment inventory and accountability, equipment check-out and turn-in, equipment serviceability and cleaning, instructional training of equipment and activities, trip and/or activities guides, and other duties as needed.

Must meet requirements and/or experiences:

Mountain bike trail riding, basic bicycle upkeep and repair, and laws for bicycle use. Canoeing/kayaking experience, watercraft/waterway laws of use, and hiking/camping experience. Knowledge of state and national parks, campsite preparation, animal/plant identification, outdoor navigation, first aid and CPR. Knowledge in Microsoft Office, instructional training, and supervisor experience.
