Founded in 1907, the University of Central Arkansas (UCA) is a state institution located in the city of Conway, Arkansas. UCA's most famous alumnus is former NBA star Scottie Pippen.

With enrollment of nearly 12,000 and a student to faculty ratio of 19 to 1, UCA offers more than 100 undergraduate courses of study, more than 30 master's degree programs and 5 doctoral programs.

UCA is the highest ranked Arkansas public university among regional universities in the South. U.S. News and World Report 2011 Best Colleges ranks the University of Central Arkansas 17th out of 69 public universities in the category of "Top Public Schools" among regional universities in the South.
