Possible Sanctions for violating the Academic Integrity Policy

- 1. Zero points for the project, assignment, or exam.
- 2. Zero points for the project, assignment, or exam and course grade lowered by one letter grade.
- 3. F (failing) grade or reduced grade for the course
- 4. Disqualification, suspension or expulsion from the College of Education/University

Student Obligation

- To be honest
- ► To do your own work
- To be ethical
- To do what is moral and fair

Academic Integrity: Summary

As a College of Education student it is a priority to act in an honest, ethical and professional manner.

- Students must adhere to the Academic Integrity Policy (AIP).
- Students have an ethical obligation to submit their own work.
- Students need to take reasonable measures to avoid having their work be copied.
- Violations of the AIP can result in disqualification, suspension or expulsion from the COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY.
- Honesty is the best policy.
