Tenure-Track Position in Mathematics Education

The Department of Mathematics at the University of Central Arkansas is seeking to a tenure-track assistant professor position in mathematics education, beginning August 2015.

Currently, the Department has 19 full-time faculty members and 15 graduate assistants and offers undergraduate degrees with emphasis in applied mathematics, mathematics, and mathematics education. In addition UCA offers masters degrees in applied mathematics and mathematics education. UCA is among only three state universities in Arkansas that offers a mathematics education program replicating the prestigious UTeach Program.

The position requires a doctorate in mathematics education or equivalent. Preference will be given to candidates with specialty in middle or secondary level education but all educators with active research in any area of mathematics education in middle, secondary, or above are encouraged to apply. At the undergraduate level, the UTeach Program attracts students who are strong in mathematics and applied mathematics to pursue certification in teaching secondary mathematics. Our masters program attracts recent graduates and current teachers from all over central Arkansas, with some graduate students now choosing our newly created thesis option. Responsibilities include:

- Teaching undergraduate and graduate mathematics education courses, with the possibility of teaching other mathematics courses. The regular teaching load is 12 credit hours per semester, which can include supervising student teachers. A course reduction for research is available.
- Advising, supervising, and mentoring undergraduate and graduate students in course selection and research endeavors.
- Establishing/continuing a productive research agenda in mathematics education.
- Being part of a vibrant and active community of mathematics educators in the department and STEM educators throughout the university.

Applicants should submit: a letter of application, current vita, copies of graduate transcripts, statements of teaching and research philosophy, and three letters of reference.
