**Spring Admission Curriculum Pattern
Part-time – 24 Month**

Admission begins in the fall or spring semester. Full-time students admitted in the fall will graduate in August. Those admitted in the spring will graduate in December. Below is the 24-month part-time schedule. A part-time schedule will allow the student to take the ½ semester courses and 1 summer course the first year, followed by the two 15 week courses and the remaining 10 week summer course. Currently, each course is offered only once a year (other than NURS 4245 which students take their first semester).
