

## Tenure-Track Assistant Professor Position Ph.D. Counseling Psychology (APA Accredited)

The Department of Psychology and Counseling at the University of Central Arkansas (UCA) invites applications for an Assistant Professor, tenure-track position, to begin August 15, 2017. A PhD in Counseling Psychology (preferred) or Clinical Psychology from an accredited program and license-eligibility are required. Scholarship and expertise in integrated health care, health psychology, prevention, and strength-based approaches is preferred; however, outstanding applicants with other specializations will be considered. In particular, we are eager to support applicants who may bring diversity to the program, the department, and the university.

## **Position Responsibilities**

- Serve as a core member of the APA-accredited program in Counseling Psychology.
- Teach courses in line with program and department needs e.g., graduate and undergraduate courses in counseling psychology, health psychology, abnormal psychology, multicultural psychology, and practicum.
- Conduct an active program of research and scholarship with a clearly articulated agenda within the field of counseling psychology.
- Mentor students through academic advising, research, and dissertation supervision.
- Serve the department, university, and community in ways that promote professional psychology.

## The Department of Psychology and Counseling

The department houses undergraduate program with over 500 majors and graduate programs in Counseling Psychology, School Psychology, and Mental Health Counseling. Our program in Counseling Psychology is accredited by APA and has a "general practitioner" emphasis. We also have a NASP/NCATE approved MS program and an APA-accredited PhD program in School Psychology. Department faculty include experimental and applied psychologists who are active researchers and committed teachers. The Department is located within the College of Health and Behavioral Sciences with opportunities for collaborations with other health professionals.
