

Procedures for Events in Front of the Student Center

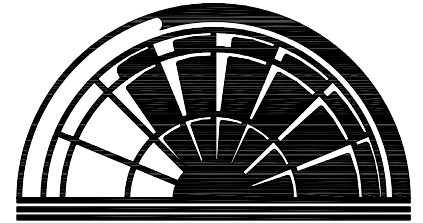
While the University recognizes the importance that outdoor events contribute to the life of the community, these events must not interfere with the educational purpose of the university including classes, recitals, and theatrical programs.

There are three areas in front of the Student Center (SC) that can be reserved: SC Courtyard, Street, and the Plaza. See the map below for the locations of these areas. Due to their proximity, amplified music can occur in only one location at a time. The organization that first reserves one of the three spaces has precedence when amplified sound is requested in more than one area.

Generally, any music requiring amplification is limited to x-periods (1:40 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.) on Tuesdays and Thursdays. This includes DJs, any acts with drums, electric guitars, electric bass guitars, etc. Sound checks may begin at 1:30 p.m. and must be kept at a very low volume. Solo acoustic acts may be exempt from this time frame as long as their volume is maintained at a reasonable level (as determined by a university official). If at any time it is determined that the volume is disturbing nearby offices or meeting rooms, groups may be required by a university official to reduce the sound level.

Nighttime events are handled on an individual basis and must be approved by the Dean of Students or his designee. If at any time it is determined that the volume is disturbing nearby offices, classrooms, or meeting rooms, groups may be required by a university official to reduce the sound level.

Failure by any RSO to adhere to these procedures may jeopardize the privilege of reserving space in front of the SC.
