



Growth mindset

When students believe they can improve and even get smarter, they are more likely to put in extra time and effort in their school work.

Growth mindset lesson units will teach basics about the brain, brain plasticity, behavior, and how we can change our brains by what we do. This will include attention and regulation, executive function skills (plan, organize, and sequence kids' thoughts), and hand-writing skills.
