Call to Order

The UCA Staff Senate was called to order at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 23, 2014 in Wingo Hall 315 by President Osborne.

Dr. Brad Teague, Athletic Director

Dr. Brad Teague, UCA Athletic Director, addressed staff senate to discuss the athletic budget. He distributed a handout that provided an overview of the athletic budget. Dr. Teague explained that the athletic budget is composed of four main revenue sources: student fees, external fundraising, auxiliary funding and educational and general funds. Athletic expenses include salaries, scholarships, team travel, medical, debt services and officials. Discussion followed.

Officers Reports

President, Lindsey Osborne announced that Elizabeth Skinner will soon deliver her baby.

President Osborne attended the last presidents meeting until the fall term. There will be some type of proposal going before the Board of Trustees regarding the University Non-discrimination Statement. The Student Government Association awarded Dave Dennis as Ally of the Year.

President Osborne received an anonymous note regarding a concern about people listening to phone calls on campus. She brought it up with President Courtway and he was unaware of any such concern. President Osborne asked if these conversations could be requested under Freedom of Information. President Courtway stated that the conversations are not and only the number can be requested. No one can listen to phone calls without a warrant from a judge. Arkansas law states that this is a one-party consent state, meaning that either the caller or the person being called can record the conversation without the other party knowing. However, outsiders to the conversation cannot tap into lines or record without a warrant. Discussion followed.

The Non-classified vacation accrual was discussed, but a decision has not been made.

Vice President, Chad Hearne gave an update on Staff Senate elections. Electronic voting will be held April 28 - 30, 2014. Discussion followed.

Front and Center Committee, Meghan Thompson announced that there were about two hundred participants at the Front and Center Reception. The campus initiative proposals email will be going out today. The final Front and Center event will be held in June and invitations will go to donors who have given this past year.

University Committee Reports

Student Success and Retention Council, Chad Hearne reported that Dr. Julia Winden-Fey gave a presentation on the Office of Student Success including the Summer Bridge Program and Supplemental Instruction Programs.

Strategic Budget Advisory Committee, Chad Hearne reported that the committee recognized the outgoing committee members. There was discussion on the Shared Governance Survey. There was also discussion about the vote that passed SBAC at the previous meeting stating that Disability Support Services' mandatory funding not be brought before SBAC in the future. Any additional budgetary needs to help the unit run smoothly or add extra programming should come through SBAC, but that federally mandatory support funding should be taken care of through their chain of command rather than through the new funding proposal process.

Strategic Planning and Resource Council, Lindsey Osborne met and discussed the Shared Governance Survey, reviewed terms and replacements for SPC and SBAC. New terms will start June 1 and committee orientation will be held. The Council of Deans minutes of April 9 regarding SBAC budget requests were discussed and Dr. Reese will follow up with Provost Runge and Diane Newton.
