

Video Compression


Using ClipChamp to compress your video file size



Open Chrome and go to this website: <https://clipchamp.com/>

Click the *Select or Drop File* button.

Browse to your video file, select and open it.



Change the output type to Mobile

Click the Start button after selecting Mobile as the output size.

Please note: The estimated file size is not likely to be accurate. If the final video after compression is not small enough, run the process again choosing a smaller value than 480p (as seen to the right).
