## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:**

### Chinese Language Instruction:

These are classes for children ages 5-15 with a primary focus on oral communication and secondary focus in the higher level class on recognizing and producing Chinese characters. The teachers will use pictures, hands-on activities such as songs, games and interactive teaching techniques to build vocabulary and reinforce basic conversations on a variety of basic everyday topics such as food, school, transportation, locations, household objects and so on. The children will be divided by age group, and may eventually be divided by previous language exposure and level of proficiency.

*Instructors: Ms Lilian (YiYuan) Gong* and *Ms Ava (Zhifang) Jiang* are natives of China & hold M.A.s from East China Normal University in the area of Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages. Currently, they are instructors with the Confucius Institute at UCA, and enjoy sharing their language & cultural heritage with people in Arkansas. They are both patient & kind, and possess excellent dispositions for teaching young children.

#### **Exploratory Chinese Traditional Painting:**

Chinese brush painting is one of the oldest continuing art traditions in the world. In this class, the instructor will introduce children to the art of brush painting. This brushwork style involves similar techniques to Chinese calligraphy. Using a brush dipped in black or colored inks, the children will first learn how to position their hands correctly to make the various stroke patterns required for very simple nature studies. This course will mainly be exploratory with focus on developing stroke work through basic pattern repetition and working with fun motifs interesting to children

*Instructor: Ms. Hai Li Liu* received her B.A. in Fine Arts from Northwest Normal University & her M.A. in Fine Arts from Xuzhou Normal University in Jiangsu Province, China. This area of China is well-known not only for its historic importance, but also for being a center for culture & the arts. Ms. Liu is a distinguished member of the Art Department faculty at Xuzhou Normal University. This year, she is a visiting professor with the UCA Confucius Institute. Ms. Liu has received many awards and honors during her 15 years of teaching painting and the fine arts. A very kind and patient teacher, she delights in sharing her culture's rich artistic tradition with students from all over the world.
