In 1998 Carol and Robert Adcock of Conway began contributing to an endowed study abroad scholarship fund for the University of Central Arkansas students pursuing study in a foreign language and teacher licensure. The Adcocks have lived in Belgium and Mrs. Adcock has studied in Paris and Mexico. Having taught foreign languages at both UCA and Conway High School, she believes that "it is important for teachers of foreign languages to have studied and lived in a foreign country so they can share those experiences with their students."
