REVISED (1/09) FLOWCHART FOR MINORS IN GERMAN

- A minor in German requires a minimum of 18 hours at the 2310 level or above:
- 1. These 18 hours must include:
 - * German 2310, 2320, and 3300
 - * Three hours of culture/civilization **or** literature (German 3312,3320, 4395)
 - * Six hours chosen from among the following: 2330,3303,3312, 3320, 3160, 3260, 3340, 4350, 4395
- 2. Satisfactory performance on proficiency tests upon entrance to and exit from the program.
- 3. A minimum grade of C in each course applying to the major program.
- Summer or a semester of study in a German-speaking country is strongly encouraged but not required.

THE FOLLOWING COURSES ARE REQUIRED OF ALL MINORS

• The first **three courses** (9 credits) **SHOULD BE TAKEN IN SEQUENCE**, one semester at a time, for students who begin study at UCA in German 23 10 or lower:

1) German 2310

2) German 2320

3) German 3300*

Conv. & Comp. II

Advanced Gram. & Comp I

- * note in exceptional cases, by permission of the ins/rue/or the chair, a student may begin to take another 3000-level course concurrently with 3300. If scheduling problems created an unresolvable conflict or would cause a delay in student's dale of graduation, 3303 could be taken before 3300.
- German minors may take any upper division German course after completing 2320, but must take ONE course from the following categories (3 credits total):

CIVILIZATION

LITERATURE

German 3312 (German Civilization)

- **German 3320** (Introduction to German Literature)
- The 4000-level classes should be taken after completion of German 3303:
 - **German 4395** (Advanced German Literature)
 - German 4300 (Directed Independent Studies)-Topic as approved by instructor.

ELECTIVES: MINORS IN GERMAN MUST SELECT § MORE HOURS OF ELECTIVES.

- Note: The 4000-level classes should be taken after completion of two 3000-level courses:
- German 3303 Advanced Comp. & Conversation II
- Civilization (German 3312) or Literature (German 3320)
- **Practicum** courses (3160/3260)
- Intensive Oral Practice Abroad in German (3340), with approval of chair and advisor.
- Business German (2330)
- Theme courses in Literature (4395) may be repeated under different topics
- Grammar and Phonetics (4350)

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- German 1310 and 1320 may not be used as credit toward completion of the minor.
- The World Language (1300, 1310, 2315, 2325, 2350, 4315, 4325, 4330) classes do NOT count towards minor in German
- In order to graduate, every UCA student must have a total of **124** semester hours and **40** upper-division hours; **24** of the last **30** hours must be completed in residence.
