## Modern Languages Major: Spanish Concentration Business Track

A major in Modern Languages with a concentration in Spanish (Business Track) requires a minimum of 37 total hours (34 in Spanish and 3 in World Languages or Linguistics). WLAN courses (with the exception of 2350 and 3390) and Spanish 1310, 1320, 1330 and 2300 DO NOT count toward the Spanish major. In addition, students must achieve satisfactory performance on proficiency tests upon entrance to and exit from the major program, and a minimum grade of C in each course applying to the major program. Sequencing: None of the courses in the language block may be taken before successful completion of the previous course. After successful completion of 2310, students may begin to take certain electives, such as 2325, 2350 or 2330 concurrently with Spanish 2320 and above. After completion of 3300, most courses may be taken concurrently. Although it is not a pre-requisite, it is recommended that students complete 3303 before taking any literature courses. For other classes, please review the prerequisites in *Undergraduate Bulletin*.

#### Important notes:

- Summer or a semester of study in a Spanish-speaking country is strongly encouraged.
- All majors must complete a minor. Courses may <u>not</u> be double counted for both a major and a minor. See *UG Bulletin*.
- In order to graduate, every UCA student must have a total of 120 semester hours and 40 upper-division hours; 24 of the last 30 hours must be completed in residence.
- Courses used to meet area requirements in one block may not be double counted in another!!
- Certain courses <u>may</u> be double counted toward a second <u>major</u> (e.g. BA in International Studies, International Trade, Linguistics, etc). See program requirements in *UG Bulletin*.
