A period of non-enrollment of 12 months or more requires that the student adhere to the agreement revision corresponding with the academic year of re-enrollment.

³ PLEASE NOTE: In order to be eligible for admission to the UCA Family and Consumer Sciences Teacher Education program, ASUB students must earn a "C" or higher in <u>all</u> of the courses listed within the "English/Communication", "Mathematics", and "Family and Consumer Sciences Education Core" categories. A passing score on the Praxis Core Assessment (or satisfactory scores on the ACT or SAT as per Arkansas Department of Education guidelines), is also required. Please see your advisor and/or contact the UCA Family and Consumer Sciences Education department if you have questions about these requirements.

⁴ UCA course is either guaranteed by ACTS (acts.adhe.edu) or by UCA Department Chair approval (if blank, elective credit will be awarded). ⁵ ASUB EDU 1103 has been approved as equivalent to UCA MSIT 3310, fulfilling UD UCA Core: D, R requirements.

⁶ As per the Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS), PSY 2533 will officially transfer to UCA as PSYC 2370. However, the UCA Family and Consumer Sciences Education department will allow PSY 2533 to serve as a substitute for the FACS 2341 course requirement.

⁷ Students completing the AS in Liberal Arts and Sciences degree, as shown above, with a minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA, will have satisfied the UCA Lower-Division Core. Upon successful completion of the admission process as outlined – <u>uca.edu/ocs/admission-requirements/</u> – students will be eligible for admission to the UCA College of Education.
