A passing score on the Praxis I exam (or satisfactory scores on the ACT or SAT as per Arkansas Department of Education guidelines), is also required. Please see your advisor if you have questions about these requirements.

<sup>5</sup> Students earning equivalent credit to MSIT 3310 will have fulfilled UCA Upper-Division Core requirements D and R.

<sup>6</sup> Students completing the AS in Education degree, as shown above, with a minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA, will have satisfied the UCA Lower-Division Core. Upon successful completion of the admission process as outlined here ([uca.edu/teaching/mladmission](http://uca.edu/teaching/mladmission) and [uca.edu/ocs/admission-requirements](http://uca.edu/ocs/admission-requirements)), students will be eligible for admission to the UCA College of Education.
