³ PLEASE NOTE: In order to be eligible for admission to the UCA Teacher Education program, COTO students must earn a "C" or higher in <u>all</u> of the courses within the "English/Communication" and "Mathematics" categories, as well as in any of the professional education and content track courses taken at COTO. A passing score on all three sections of the Praxis Core exam (or satisfactory scores on the corresponding sections of the ACT or SAT as per Arkansas Department of Education guidelines), is also required. Please see your advisor if you have questions about these requirements.

⁴ UCA course is either guaranteed by ACTS (acts.adhe.edu) or by UCA Department Chair approval (if blank, elective credit will be awarded).

⁵ Students earning equivalent credit to MSIT 3310 will have fulfilled UCA Upper-Division Core requirements D and R.

⁶ Students completing the AS in Liberal Arts and Sciences degree, as shown above, with a minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA, will have satisfied the UCA Lower Division Core. Upon successful completion of the admission process as outlined here (<u>uca.edu/teaching/mladmission</u> and <u>uca.edu/ocs/admission-requirements</u>), students will be eligible for admission to the UCA College of Education.
