Pre-Admission Requirements

- Applicants must have earned a Diploma or Associate's degree in Nursing from Baptist Health College Little Rock
- o Applicants must possess an unencumbered Registered Nurse (RN) license within the State of Arkansas
- Applicants must have completed the State Minimum General Education Core Curriculum (35 hours)
- Applicants must have completed an additional 14 hours of specified courses and have at least a 2.75 cumulative GPA
- \circ Applicants must submit all required documentation for general admission to UCA and the Nursing program
