³ PLEASE NOTE: In order to be eligible for admission to the UCA Social Studies (History) Teacher Education program, NWACC students must earn a "C" or higher in all of the courses within the "English/Communication", "Mathematics", and "Social Studies Education Core" categories. A passing score on all three sections of the Praxis Core exam (or satisfactory scores on the corresponding sections of the ACT or SAT as per Arkansas Department of Education guidelines), is also required. Please see your advisor and/or contact the UCA History department if you have questions about these requirements.

⁴ UCA course is either guaranteed by ACTS (acts.adhe.edu) or by UCA Department Chair approval (if blank, elective credit will be awarded).
