A period of non-enrollment of 12 months or more requires that the student adhere to the agreement revision corresponding with the year of re-enrollment.

² UCA course is either guaranteed by ACTS (acts.adhe.edu) or by UCA Department Chair approval (if blank, elective credit will be awarded).

³ Depending upon the Math course chosen, general elective credit may have to be adjusted in order to reach a total of 60 credit hours.

⁴ FREN 1003 (UCA: FREN 1310) - FREN 1013 (UCA: 1320) - FREN 2003 (UCA: FREN 2310) sequence can also be used to fulfill this requirement.

⁵ Students completing the AS in Liberal Arts and Sciences degree requirements, as shown above, with a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA, will have satisfied the UCA Lower-Division Core and will be admitted to the BA in Psychology degree program as a junior.
