<sup>3</sup> UCA course is either guaranteed by ACTS (acts.adhe.edu) or by UCA Department Chair approval (if blank, elective credit will be awarded).

<sup>4</sup> FREN 1311 (UCA: FREN 1310) - FREN 1312 (UCA: 1320) - FREN 2311 (UCA: FREN 2310) sequence can also be used to fulfill this requirement.

<sup>5</sup> PSYC 2330 will count toward the 9 elective hours required for the psychology degree, but not toward the required 40 hours of UCA upper-division credits.

<sup>6</sup> Students completing the AS in Liberal Arts and Sciences degree requirements, as shown above, with a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA, will have satisfied the UCA Lower-Division Core and will be admitted to the BA in Psychology degree program as a junior.

<sup>9</sup> This agreement requires 120 credit hours as follows: maximum 60 at PTC and remaining 60 at UCA (40 of which must be upper-division).
