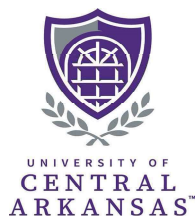

<sup>8</sup> HIST 2390 is a prerequisite for a history major to enroll in HIST 3390. HIST 3390 is a corequisite/prerequisite for history major to enroll in any 4000-level course that counts toward a major. HIST 4300 has prerequisites of 21 hours of completed history credit hours and HIST 3390. A grade of C or above is required in HIST 4300 to graduate in the major.

<sup>10</sup> This agreement requires 120 credit hours as follows: maximum 60 at NPC and remaining 60 at UCA (40 of which must be upper-division).
